

4D3N DANANG – HOI AN

Itinerary:

Day 1: Arrival Danang – Hoi An (Dinner included)

Arrival Danang, meet and greet by local representative. Proceed to Hoi An ancient town which lies on the banks of the Thu Bon River. Hoi An was one of the major trading centers of Southeast Asia in the 16th century and was declared a World Cultural Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1999. Continue explore the Hoi An countryside by sampan including the Thanh Ha earthenware village. Overnight at hotel in Hoi An.

Day 2: Hoi An UNESCO's World Cultural Heritage Site (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner included)

Morning discover Hoi An ancient town, which was originally a Cham seaport but has been influenced down centuries by a myriad of traders from various cultures. There are plenty to see in this tranquil and delightful town, some of which are the famous Japanese Covered Bridges, the Pottery Museum, the 200 years old Tamky House, the Chua Ong Pagoda and the bustling market. We visit these sights on an exciting walking tour past many low tiled houses scattered along the small streets and assembly halls which reflect the town's multi-cultural past. Enjoy cyclo tour around Hoi An Ancient town. Afternoon, free at leisure for your swimming on Cua Dai Beach or just relax at hotel or shopping in the old town. Overnight at hotel in Hoi An.

Day 3: Hoi An - Danang (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner included)

Morning transfer to visit Danang city, the fourth largest city in Vietnam, the gateway to the central provinces and a sea port with nice beaches and resort. We visit the Cham Museum, the Non Nuoc Beach and the Marble Mountain, whose peaks represent the five elements of the universe. Then check in hotel for refresh. Afternoon, free at leisure for your relax or shopping around the city. Overnight at hotel in Danang.

Day 4: Danang – Departure

Free at leisure until transfer to Danang airport for your departure.
